SCVAA 3 on 3 rules for 2nd Grade:

- 1. A game will consist of 9 minutes running time.
- 2. Teams score by either two point baskets or by 1 point free throws after fouls. Baskets are at 8" height.
- 3. Game play starts past the three point arc before a basket may be attempted. The ball must be checked after each made basket.
- 4. Possession is given alternately for baskets made.
- 5. On defensive rebounds, players must return the ball by dribble or pass past the three point arc. Once past the top of the key, or three point line, the ball does not need to be checked. Free backs.
- 6. After a basket the team scored upon will put the ball in play.
- 7. Fouls are called by coaches only. Any foul in the act of shooting will be awarded 2 shots. Also, free throws will be shot from a shorter distance. (12.5 ft.)
- 8. A ball that goes out of bounds under the basket is checked in behind the three point arc.
- 9. Defense gets all jump balls.
- 10. Substitutions may be made after made baskets or after an alternate possession. This will allow teams to rotate sideline players into the game.
- More than anything else we want the second grade program to be the best learning experience that we can offer.
