

Cancellation Policy

If you need to cancel a registration, you must notify us at 651-351-8300 at least **3 full working days** before the class begins. We will refund the class fee minus a \$10 processing fee. Full refunds will be issued for classes that are cancelled by Community Education. **Refunds will not be given within 3 working days of the start date or after the class has started.** This policy is necessary for us to provide the best service to our customers. District 834 check cashing policies have changed. Effective immediately, checks returned unpaid will be recovered electronically by E-Cap along with a state allowed recovery fee.
